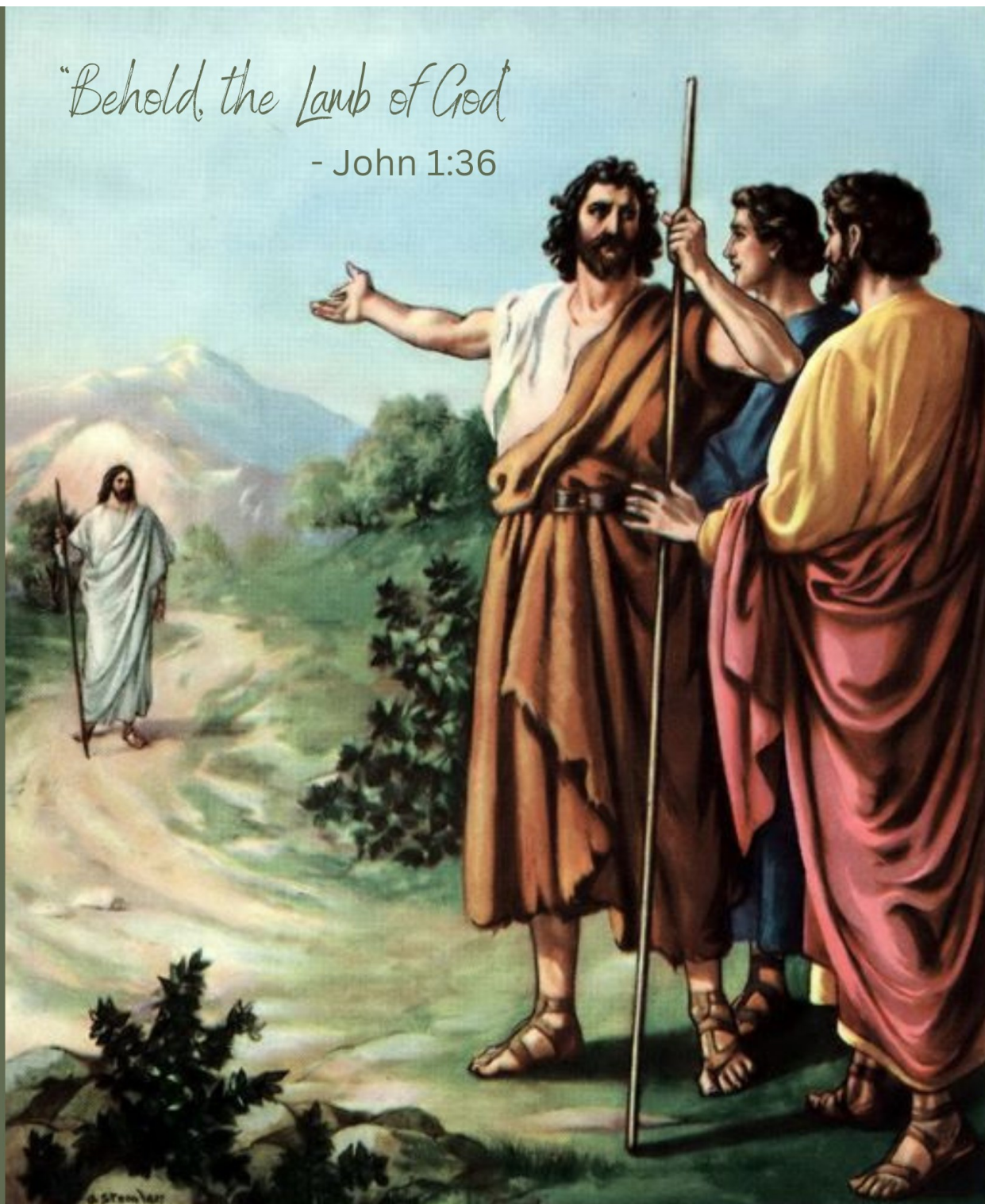

## DAY OF PRAYER FOR THE LEGAL PROTECTION OF UNBORN CHILDREN JANUARY 22, 2024

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM), no. 373, designates Jan. 22 as a particular day of prayer and penance, called the "Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children." In all the Dioceses of the United States of America, Jan. 22 (or Jan. 23, when Jan. 22 falls on a Sunday) shall be observed as a particular day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion.

## IC'S LITTLE ROCK SCRIPTURE STUDY

### The Gospel of Mark begins in February

Would you like to know Christ better? Learn new insights into how to love and follow Him? You can do that by gathering together with fellow parishioners this Lent in the study of the Gospel of Mark, Part 1.

The Gospel of Mark is the shortest of the four gospels, the first gospel written, and is considered to be told from the perspective of St. Peter. It is also the gospel being used in our current cycle of Mass readings. It challenges us in our discipleship. Are we willing to take up our cross and follow Christ despite the costs?

When? Thursday mornings (10:15-noon) or evenings (6:45-8:30) (but it's better to come 15 minutes early for snacks and fellowship!)

Beginning February 15 (the day after Ash Wednesday) through March 21 (the Thursday before Palm Sunday).

The Study can be a meaningful part of your Lenten journey this year.

The Study includes private reading from the Little Rock Study Guide during the week, with small group discussions and a wrap-up speaker at the Thursday meetings. Sign-ups will be in the gathering area after Masses the weekends of February 3-4 and 10-11. 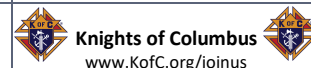
