UPCOMING RCIA INQUIRY

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is a process through which adults become members of the Roman Catholic Church. This consists of steps, periods, and rites that make up the model of Christian Initiation as restored in the second Vatican Council.

Has a family member or friend ever expressed an interest in the Catholic Church? Or maybe you yourself have never been baptized, or have been baptized in another Christian tradition, and feel that God may now be calling you toward the Church. If so, the RCIA is here to help. This is a process that is concerned with the total formation of the individual considering membership in the Catholic Church. Because it is a process and not a pre-set program that is the same for everyone, RCIA can meet people where they are on their faith journeys and help them to develop their relationship with God, His Church, and the Immaculate Conception Parish community.

We will have 3 inquiry meetings during the summer months for those interested in joining the church on the 3rd Mondays of July and August. Classes will begin the 2nd Monday of September. If you know anyone who is interested please have them call our parish office to let us know which meeting they will be attending. Or you can speak to me directly after Mass on Sundays.

2024-2025 CODE OF CONDUCT

The 2024-2025 Code of Conduct will become available on July 1, 2024 and will be accessible through the Office of Child and Youth Protection Webpage at: <https://dioscg.org/child-youth-protection/> under the Prevention and Protection tab. It may also be accessed through VIRTUS. The Code of Conduct is required annually for all clergy, employees, and volunteers. The 2023-24 Code of Conduct will expire on Dec. 31, 2024 and anyone who has not submitted the 2024-2025 Code of Conduct will be made inactive in VIRTUS and ineligible to work or volunteer with minors and vulnerable adults.

After verification from the state, you will receive an Email receipt. Include the receipt and a MO-TC form with your state income tax filing. 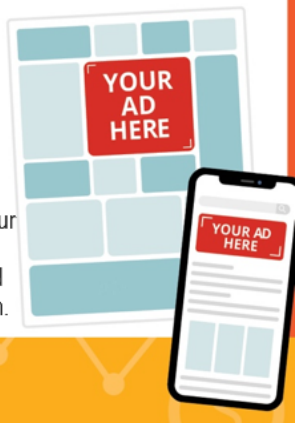
