

From Father Belken's Desk

As many of you know, a couple of summers ago, I went on an Ignatian Thirty Day Retreat at a retreat center in South Dakota. The experience was extremely beneficial to me in a variety of ways, some expected, and others quite unexpected. I remember one unexpected message in particular: that I needed to stop the "busyness" on occasion for intentional times to rest and reconnect with God.

That message was difficult at that time. As I came in on the heels of my ordination as a transitional deacon, along with having finished a busy third year of theological studies at Kenrick, I had grown quite accustomed to a very lively and booked schedule. I'd be charging right back in to finish up my last year. I had to finish a thesis. I had done a lot, and had more to do. Yet, what was most necessary then? To rest and pray.

Last week, we heard how Jesus commissioned the Twelve Apostles and sends them out to preach repentance, to drive out demons, and to anoint the sick. This week, after all of the "busyness," they come back together and Jesus gives them a very simple encouragement: "Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while." It may seem like a sudden shift: one moment, the Twelve are being sent out to do all sorts of types of work, and then the next they are being told to take some quiet time away to rest. However, it is an important point for the Twelve to consider: their work and their ministry takes energy. It requires a lot of vigilance, and can be tiring. To be effective ministers, they need to take their own requirements for prayer and rest into account. They must attend to their needs to attend to the needs of the people.

In our day and age, we aren't likely struggling with having "nothing to do," but we are struggling with having too much to do. In fact, we may have so much to do that it causes us to either push back on our prayer life, or start to forget it altogether. However, Jesus's reminder for the Twelve is an excellent reminder for us all: the more that we have to do, the more we need to rest and pray. Will this time of prayer look the same for all of us? Can we all expect to pray, say, for thirty days of silence? Absolutely not. Yet, it is up to us to commit ourselves to resting in God when we should. When we have so much to do, never forget the bare Fr. Belken

essentials: take time to rest and to pray.
