

Rocks or Cathedrals: What Do You See?

"A pile of rocks ceases to be a pile a rocks when someone has a cathedral in mind." (Antoine de Saint-Exupery, as quoted by Donna Schaper in "These Days," September-October, 1999, Volume 30 - No. 5, Tuesday, September 21.)

When you look in the mirror what do you see?

What do you see when you look around this sanctuary at all of these people? Go on look at them! Have you ever really looked at the faces of those sit in front of you or behind you or on the far left side or the far right side?

What do you see when you look out at the world through the newspapers you read and the television you watch?

- ☐ Participate in parish ministries, activities, and organizations through your contribution of time and talent.
- □ Support the ministries of the Catholic Church by pledging and tithing sacrificially to your parish.
- □ Completing Immaculate Conception's Faith Commitment
- □ Placing parish offertory envelope with pledge, prayer of petition and/or prayer of thanksgiving weekly in the Sunday collection. Immaculate Conception envelopes placed in the collection at any Catholic Church will be forward to Immaculate Conception. Weekly participation at Mass is verified through the use of offertory envelopes at Mass or by mailing your offertory envelope weekly to the Parish Office.
