

#### WEDNESDAY BREAKFAST MINISTRY

Dear fellow IC parishioners,

Thank you in advance for allowing me to update you on our 'Wednesday AM Breakfast Ministry at the Vet's Coming Home Center' which is approaching its 5<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. This has been possible only because of the ongoing financial and volunteer support from our parish.

Noteworthy is the fact that since the inception of this ministry, Easter 2018, our parish has NOT missed even one Wednesday providing breakfast to those poor, hungry and homeless who rely on the Vet Center for assorted services including their meals and our Wed Breakfasts.

Please know that even through Covid our parish funded breakfast each and every Wednesday. While we were forced to scale back the preparing & serving onsite at the Vet Center because of Covid, I.C. funded every Wednesday breakfast which was prepared and served by the staff during this difficult period. We are approaching 260 consecutive Wednesdays providing a much-needed meal to our friends in need. During this 5-year period I.C. will have served over 25,000 people approximately 40,000 meals.

A very special thanks to our Knights, SVDP, PCCW and our Parish Council for providing volunteers to prepare and serve these breakfasts, as well as the dozens and dozens of our fellow parishioners who also volunteered for this ministry.

Finally, I would like to make a special plea to those who are able to consider a modest donation (check payable to the "I.C.

Breakfast Ministry") so we can continue this special weekly Wednesday outreach effort allowing us to live out Jesus' Gospel message to "help the poor and feed the hungry."

And MOST important – to all I.C. parishioners, please pray for those whom our ministry serves that they see Jesus in our generosity, care, and love for them. May God continue to bless our Immaculate Conception Parish!


