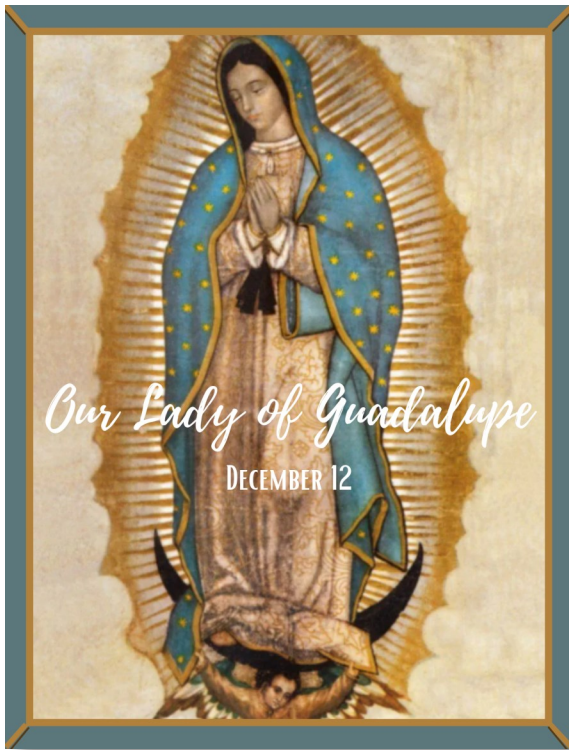

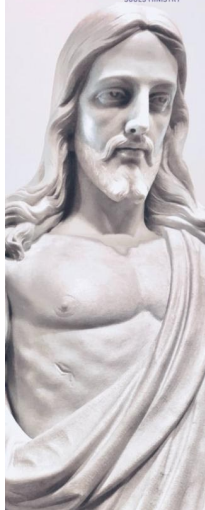
DIOCESAN SACRED HEART PILGRIMAGE CHALLENGE

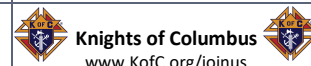
