From Father Belken's Desk

"Did I make enough for dinner?"

It was the perennial question around the house, being the oldest of six boys. While I quite enjoyed cooking, that was always the question that sat in the back of my mind. Is this pot of chili going to be enough? Was that roast big enough? Will there be enough dessert for everyone to be happy with dinner? If there wasn't enough, there was going to be some amount of grumbling, which I wanted to avoid at all costs!

This weekend, we switch to the sixth chapter of John, which we will follow until the weekend of August 22nd (with the exception of two feast days). We all likely have a basic understanding of why this chapter is so important: it is the "Bread of Life" discourse, which would be controversial, but also now central to our faith in it's fulfillment in the Eucharist. However, the discourse starts with the miracle of the multiplication of fish and loaves. This may not seem to be a direct correlation to the teachings, however, in reality, it has everything to do with the setting the stage for what Jesus is about to say next. The Gospel relates that the crowd is hungry. and so, when the disciples start searching for food, their result is meager, to say the least: five loaves and two fish, to split amongst the crowd of five thousand men (not including children and women). Yet, Jesus performs an astonishing miracle: the five loaves and two fish are not simply sufficient, but they are truly abundant: twelve wickers baskets were filled with the leftovers. This clearly isn't just the people learning how to share: they ate and were truly satisfied.

Recently, we have also been hearing about how the disciples have been commissioned to go out and to preach and teach the good news: something that would seem profound. However, when we look at our responsibility as disciples, we are often simply called to preach the Gospel in our little ways. Sometimes, this is when we have patience, give a word of encouragement, or even plant some small seed or share some faith with our children. We may think that all of these things are inconsequential: there are only five loaves and two fish in the face of five thousand. Perhaps this could cause us to wonder "is it enough?" The challenge for us, my brothers and sisters, isn't to feed the five thousand ourselves, nor to completely change someone's life on our own. It's to simply show up with the little we have to offer, and to trust that God will feed the five thousand if we simply have faith. So, go out, and preach the Gospel, even in small

ways. Who knows? With some faith perhaps we *can* feed five thousand.
