The Immaculate Conception Nursery is available during Mass on Sunday at 9am & 11am!

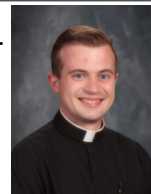

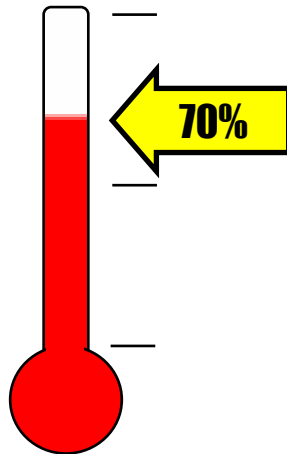
