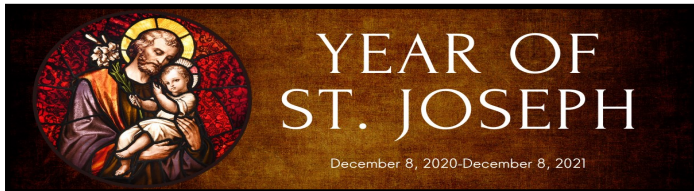

From Father Belken's Desk



When I had the privilege to travel to the Holy Land with my classmates last January, it was a truly remarkable trip. While there, we went to church after church that commemorated anything from the Annunciation to the Holy Sepulcher. There were a seemingly inexhaustible number of astounding sites that were magnificent to behold!

That said, it was also frequent to be astonished by the locations and sites, not at the majesty but at how pitiful and poor they appeared. One example of this was the Jordan River. While many of us had a certain idea of a beautiful, clear, sparkling river, the reality was much less extraordinary than expected. It was a muddy, weedy, dirty mess: a far cry from what we would've expected from the place of Christ's baptism.

This weekend, we see a similar expectation and reality: the extraordinary and the seemingly ordinary. The Nazoreans beheld Jesus, the greatest man to ever walk the earth, and immediately say, "Is this not the carpenter, the son of Mary?" They see Jesus, it seems that He didn't quite fit the bill of who they were expecting. Thus, they were not filled with faith, but instead were filled with confusion and bewilderment.

While we may not encounter Jesus walking in our midst physically in the same way, as if we were looking at another person, the gift of faith shows us that we still do find Him in our midst, though it often looks very ordinary. A host that becomes His Body, even though the appearance remains the same. Wine becomes His Blood. The Bible is God's inspired word, yet it still uses the same style cover as countless other books on our shelves. We see so many ordinary things that truly are extraordinary, beneath the surface. Something altogether extraordinary is actually here.

The beauty of the many different ways that Jesus works in our life on a day-to-day basis is that it is often done in ordinary ways, or the things that seem as if they aren't impressive or important. Like the Jordan River, they may appear to be unimpressive or unimportant. However, with the gift of faith, we know something, or rather someone, truly extraordinary is in our midst. The challenge for us is to have open hearts to see Him, even in his "ordinary" appearances.
