



## **UPCOMING RCIA INQUIRY**

What is RCIA? The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process established for the universal Church for individuals to become Catholic and receive the sacraments of initiation—Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist. This initiation process also involves a parish community experiencing a renewal in faith as it prepares and welcomes new members into the Church. The Rite speaks of conversion as a "spiritual journey." Centered on fostering a deep relationship with Jesus and the Church he founded, this journey takes place through distinct stages over a period of time suitable to bring about a thorough catechesis, significant experience of the parish community, and commitment to the liturgical and moral life of the Catholic faithful.

RCIA is for those who wish to enter into full communion with the Catholic faith. Instruction for RCIA begins on the 2nd Monday of September, meets once a week and continues through the year until the Easter Vigil. Our next inquiry meeting will be Monday, August 21 at 6:30pm. General information about the program will be given that evening.
