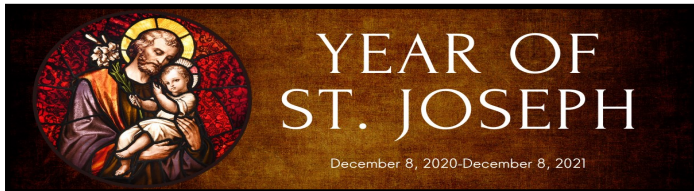

From Father Belken's Desk



You wouldn't really think it, but farmers do not simply raise new crops and livestock. He or she must also heal what is ill and to drive out whatever may harm or hurt the animals and plants in their charge. It was always amazing to see my dad at work with one of our cows or young calves, who he had noticed needed special attention. With time and due care, it was usually the case that the calf or cow, or even plants, would heal and grow strong again.

In the passage from Mark's Gospel that we heard this week-end, there is an account of Jesus commissioning the Twelve to go out on mission, specifically to preach and to heal. We could very easily gloss over the last part of the Gospel, which serves as a "report" of what the disciples did. "The Twelve drove out many demons, and they anointed with oil many who were sick and cured them" (Mk 6:13). Both of these are moments of healing, and still exist within the Catholic Church today.

The Anointing of the Sick in particular is the Sacrament that now does the same work as the anointing with oil that cured the sick in the time of the Apostles. This Sacrament has existed under many different titles, for example, "Last Rites" or "Extreme Unction" just to name a couple. Yet, what we now call "Anointing of the Sick" still is the same sacrament that Jesus commissioned the Twelve to perform at that time. The name change from times past helps to clarify that the sacrament isn't simply reserved for the most "extreme" or "last" of cases, but is really meant to be at the service of *anyone* who is suffering from a substantial illness, or even someone who is preparing to undergo surgery. Being anointed is not contingent on age, though someone who is advanced in years and is feeling the burden of their age is certainly a good candidate to receive this sacrament.

To receive the Anointing of the Sick, you certainly do not have to be "on death's door." If you or someone you love is ill, advanced in years, or facing a major surgery or operation, and has not yet or recently received this sacrament, please do not hesitate to contact me or your local priest! Through this Sacrament, whoever receives it can expect an outpouring of spiritual healing and the grace we need in the midst of illness, pain, and physical suffering.
