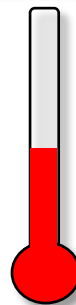


2024 DDF REPORT

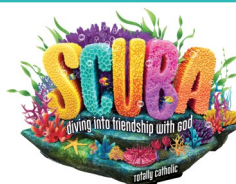
