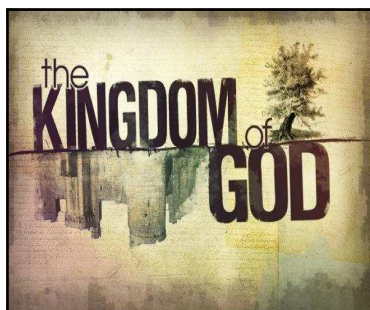

Anthony De Mello tells a story about some people who were on a raft off the coast of Brazil. They were perishing from thirst, for as you know, ocean water is undrinkable. What they did not know, however, was that the water they were floating on was fresh water. A nearby river was coming out into the sea with such force that it went out for a couple of miles, so they had fresh water right there where they were. But they had no idea. "In the same way," says De Mello, "we're surrounded with joy, with happiness, with love. Most people," he concludes, "have no idea."

And that's true. There are a lot of hurting, shattered people in this world for whom help is at hand if they only knew it. The treasure is just waiting to be discovered.

Heaven Is a Process

Most people I know believe that heaven is some far, distant place. When folks describe heaven they generally speak of some favorite place, like Myrtle Beach, Hawaii, the Smoky Mountains or a cabin in Canada. The book of the Revelation to John talks about a place where there are "streets of gold, walls with precious stones and pearl gates." Our images of heaven tend to be some form of paradise where everything is beautiful and wonderful.

But here in the gospel of Matthew Jesus does not describe "heaven" as a place. He is speaking in parables and in each parable he refers to heaven as an activity. Heaven is not a destination but a journey. For Jesus, heaven has to do with planting seeds, discovering treasure, selling everything you have and being caught up in a huge net. In other words heaven is not a place where we end up but a process we participate in.

PROJECTS TO PREPARE FOR THE FUTURE
WHEN WE CAN GATHER

- ♦ **YOUTH ROOM:** Removing old furniture, carpet and damaged ceiling tile from the lower level youth room and replacing with a hard surface floor covering. This will provide a clean and pleasant place for our youth to meet and to pray. It will also make the room accessible for our school children during a storm threat.
- ♦ **LIVESTREAMING ROOM:** Enlarging the room by four feet to provide for streaming Mass. This will enable us to make use of the WiFi signal to equipment used to connect to our parishioners who are at home and the homebound to pray with us for our celebration of the Eucharist and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.
- ♦ **CHAPEL:** Removing pews and the deteriorated carpet and replacing the flooring with a hard surface floor and chairs to provide for funerals that have a small attendance, thus allowing the accessibility of bringing a casket into the chapel for the funeral Mass.
