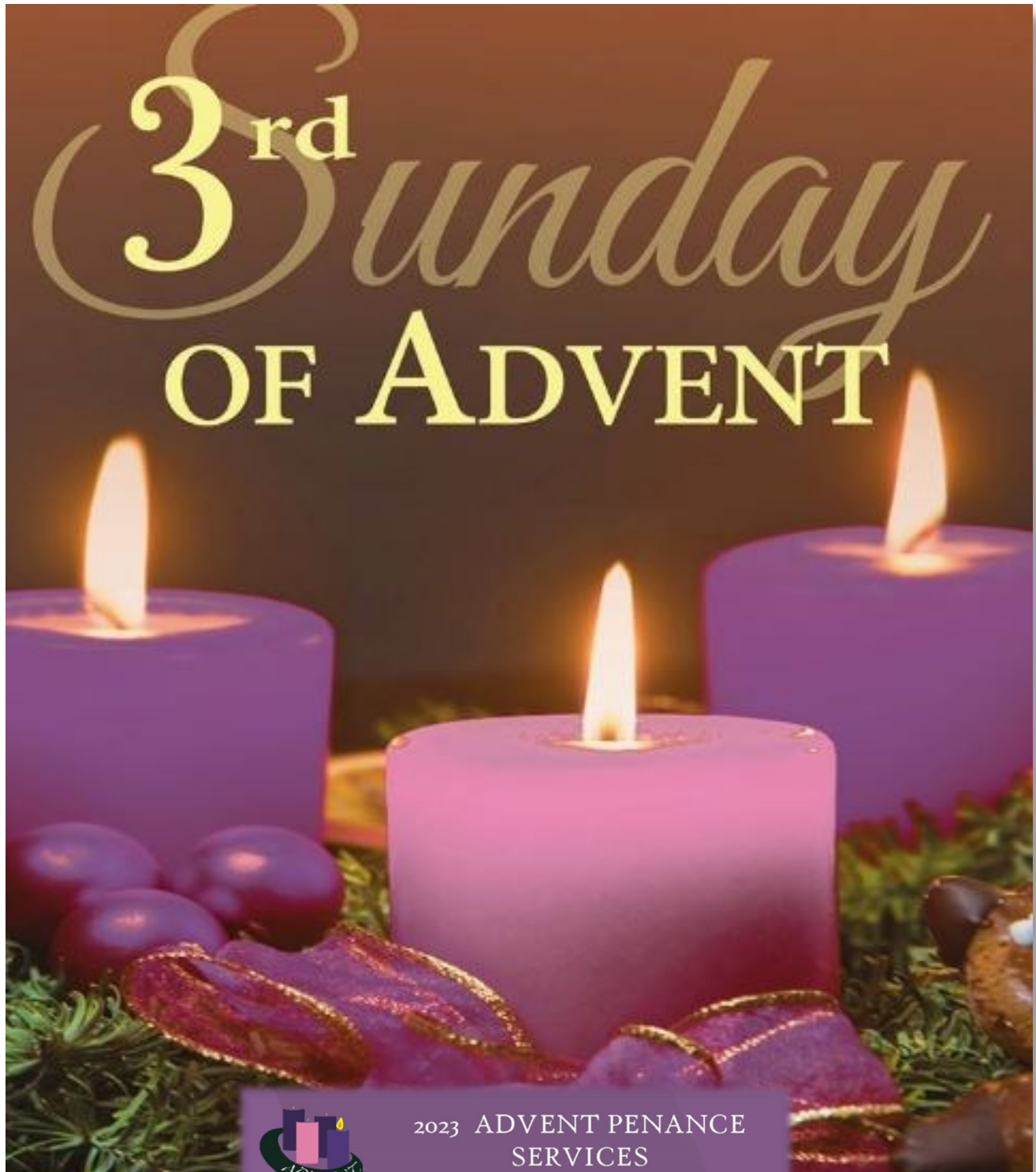

## FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT/SOLEMNITY OF THE NATIVITY OF THE LORD

Questions have been asked regarding the Masses for the Fourth Sunday of Advent (Dec. 24) and the Solemnity of the Nativity of the Lord. Please note that the Scripture readings and prayers for the anticipatory Mass on Saturday (Dec. 23) and the Sunday morning Masses on Dec. 24 are taken from the Fourth Sunday of Advent. The Scripture readings and prayers offered on the evening of Sun., Dec. 24 (Christmas Eve) are taken from the Vigil Mass of Christmas OR the Mass during the Night, when the Mass is offered later in the evening. **The faithful are reminded that there is an obligation of Mass attendance attached to both the Fourth Sunday of Advent as well as the Christmas Mass (since Christmas itself is a Holy Day of Obligation).** In short, a person cannot attend Mass on Sunday evening and have it fulfill the obligation for both Sunday and Christmas. The obligations are distinct from one another.

## SOLEMNITY OF MARY, THE HOLY MOTHER OF GOD

Please note that since January 1st falls on Monday this coming year (2024), it is NOT a Holy Day of Obligation, *though it retains its liturgical rank as a Solemnity.* While the faithful are not obligated to attend Mass on this day, **you are still strongly encouraged to attend Holy Mass** to celebrate this Mystery of our Faith. We will have a **5:30pm Vigil Mass on Sunday, December 31st, followed by Adoration until midnight (sign-up for Adoration is in the Gathering Area) and 9:00am Mass on Monday, January 1st.**

## EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION—NEW YEAR’S EVE

### Oh, Come Let Us Adore Him!

Please consider spending time with our Lord in Eucharistic Adoration on New Year’s Eve, Sunday, December 31st, following the 5:30pm Vigil Mass. 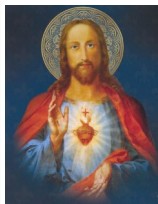
