A Note From The Pastor's Desk



As I send my greetings and take this opportunity to share a bit of my own past as a means of introduction, I would like to first express my joy and excitement in joining this wonderful parish family here at Immaculate Conception Parish.

I was born in India, to Mr. Mathew C.U. and Ann Mathew. I have only one sister, Shaly Mathew and she lives with her husband and children in India.

After high school education, I joined the seminary and graduated with a degree in Philosophy from DVK, Bangalore, India. I was then sent to Leuven University, Belgium for theological studies and graduated in 2005. I was ordained to priesthood on May 09, 2006.

I did pastoral ministry in India and Brazil until I immigrated to USA in 2011. In 2011, I joined the Diocese of Springfield Cape Girardeau and started my ministry as an associate pastor at St Peter's in Joplin and St Mary's in Lamar and then as Pastor in St Catherine of Siena in Piedmont, St Mary's in West Plains and St Joseph's in Billings. In 2018 I was blessed with an opportunity to continue studies in Canon Law and completed my JCL in 2021. In 2019, Most Reverend Bishop Edward M. Rice appointed me the Vicar General of the Diocese of Springfield Cape Girardeau. Finally, Bishop has appointed me the Pastor of Immaculate Conception Parish in Springfield.

As the weeks and months unfold, I am truly looking forward to coming to know you and journeying with you as we gather for prayer and worship. There have been many occasions within this short period of time where so many of you have communicated your prayers and support for me as your pastor. I am constantly humbled by your expressions of love and welcoming. Thank you! It is now my turn to offer my support to you and your families. As your pastor, I am available to guide you in the life of faith. I am available to celebrate the

Sacraments, rejoice with you in happy times, and cry with you during the most difficult of times. I am also available to help you with anything that is keeping you or your families away from growing in the spiritual life and developing a deeper relationship with Christ and his Church. As you work hard to protect your families, I want to equip you with the appropriate tools to form, protect, and guide you and your families on this specific issue.

I am very grateful to Very Rev. Fr. Tom Kiefer for his hard work and years of dedication to this parish and for his guidance to me as I make this transition. I pray with you all that he may find happiness and joy with the SEAS community. Also, I take this opportunity to thank Rev. Fr. Daniel Belken, my brother priest, for his ministry and his great heart to help me to settle at IC.

A clergy mentor offered me a phrase for thinking about the beginning as a priest in a parish: "learn your parish with love". For these first few months I'm focused on learning about our parish with love – the skills, gifts, and callings of individuals, as well as the history and identity of the parish. Definitely it will give an idea of "Who we are right now" "Who our neighbors are now" and "What difference we believe God is calling us to make now"

Once again, it is very nice to be here with all of you. I look forward to being your parish priest with Fr. Belken, praying with you, and sharing Christ's grace with you and your families. May the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary and St. Joseph be with you and your loved ones!
